A Busy Year for the Friends

The Friends enjoyed another successful year and we would like to thank everyone who has supported and helped with our fund raising activities.

During 2013 we contributed £14,620 to the Church, which included Church roof repairs, Bell Tower remedial work and the rendering of the south wall. This year a further £3,690 has been paid which includes central heating repairs and further roof repairs.

Your support means that you are helping future generations in the village to continue to have a beautiful church for weddings, christenings and funerals as well as somewhere quiet and peaceful to reflect when needed.

The Church is also available for concerts and other village events.

St Mary's Church is Studham's oldest building and The Friends exist to support our historic church with the maintenance and upkeep of the fabric of the building.
